<p>High Bar:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. One skill passing through a handstand</li> <li>2. One skill beginning above the bar, swinging through the bottom, and ending on top (i.e. baby giants, giants, undergrip cast, back uprise)</li> <li>3. Salto dismount</li> </ol>
<p>Pommel Horse:</p> <p>Require the two scissors to be consecutive. Stops in between will not earn requirement.</p>
<p>Parallel Bars:</p> <p>Somersault dismount must be performed <u>through</u> a support (Fly-away will not receive credit)</p>
